

Post operative instructions: EXCISION (Body)

Today you had a skin lesion removed through Excision

While most of these will heal quickly and without concern a few tips to help the process:

### 1. General care

- The water proof dressing is removed at day 3 post op
- The fabric weave dressing remains over the wound for at least 2 weeks
- After this you can shower but no swimming or baths for 2 weeks
- Torso Tape the wound every week for 6 weeks with Fixamul

### 2. Pain

- Most skin excision, if well covered with a dressing cause little or no pain
- On the day of surgery take 2 panadol when you get home and a further 2 before bed
- Nurofen and Voltaren can cause bleeding so in the first instance try Panadol.

## 3. What to watch out for

- Infection <1% of biopsies get infected but will present as:
  - o Pain getting worse after 48 hours
  - o Smell through the dressing
  - o Redness and warmth at the site
  - Fevers or feeling unwell
  - o Please contact the clinic and we will arrange urgent review

### Bleeding

- o Bleeding contained within the dressing in the first 24 hours is common
- If bleeding is occurring through the dressing apply firm pressure for 20 mins and if available apply a firm bandage
- If bleeding continues after this period please contact the clinic in hours or attend Emergency after hours.
- o If no active bleeding you can restart your blood thinner the next day

# 4. Activity

- Please refrain from all activity that places stress on the wound for 2 weeks
- No swimming for 2 weeks
